Subject: Planting God's Word and Reaping the Harvest

PROVERBS 18:21

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.” Proverbs 18:21 KJV

“Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it and indulge it will eat its fruit and bear the consequences of their words.” PROVERBS 18:21 AMP

“...[calling] into existence the things that do not exist [yet].”
Romans 4:17 ESV

“...[calling] those things which do not exist as though they did...” Romans 4:17 NKJV

[As you confess the promises of God's word, in due time they become reality - from spiritual reality to natural reality.]

We plant by faith, trusting and believing, by hearing God's Word, and allowing it to take root in the good ground of our spiritual heart – by having ears to hear. We water and fertilize

that seed of the word by confessing the Scriptures we are believing and trusting on, and we reap the harvest also with the confession of our mouth... confessing those same scriptures we are trusting in and believing on!
