Subject: Planting the Seed of God's Word concerning Healing
and Reaping the Harvest of Health

God's Word is Medicine:

“My son, attend to My words; incline your ear unto My sayings. Let them [My words] not depart from your eyes; keep them [My words] in the midst of your heart. For they [My words] are life unto those that find them, and healing, health and medicine to all their flesh.” Proverbs 4:20-22

The important thing is to read out loud the healing scriptures several times a day. The same way you would take doctor prescribed medicine in the natural, you need to take the spiritual medicine of God's word, prescribed by Dr. Jesus, several times a day.

Check out the following Healing Scriptures:

“He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.” Psalms 107:20 KJV

“[God] said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the Lord that healeth thee.” Exodus 15:26 KJV

“Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;”
Psalms 103:2-3 KJV

“O give thanks unto the Lord; call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people. Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him: talk ye of all his wondrous works.
...O ye seed of Abraham his servant, ye children of Jacob his chosen. He is the Lord our God: his judgments are in all the earth. He hath remembered his covenant for ever, the word which he commanded to a thousand generations. Which covenant he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac; And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant.
...He brought them forth also with silver and gold: and there was not one feeble person among their tribes.
...And he brought forth his people with joy, and his chosen with gladness:”

“Surely he (Messiah Jesus) hath borne our griefs and sicknesses, and carried our sorrows and pains...he (Messiah Jesus) was wounded and tormented for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement for our peace was thrust upon him; and with his stripes and bruises we are healed.” Isaiah 53:4-5 kJ+BL

“Surely our sicknesses he hath borne, And our pains--he hath carried them...” Isaiah 53:4 YLT98

“In fact, it was our diseases he bore, our pains from which he suffered...he was wounded because of our crimes, crushed because of our sins; the disciplining that makes us whole fell on him, and by his bruises* we are healed.”

Yesha 'yahu (Isa) 53:4-5 CJB

“...he endured the suffering that should have been ours, the pain that we should have borne. All the while we thought that his suffering was punishment sent by God. But because of our sins he was wounded, beaten because of the evil we did. We are healed by the punishment he suffered, made whole by the blows he received.” Isaiah 53:4-5 GNB

“But [in fact] He has borne our griefs {and sicknesses}, And He has carried our sorrows and pains; Yet we [ignorantly] assumed that He was stricken, Struck down by God and degraded and humiliated [by Him]. But He was wounded for our transgressions {Faults; offenses; crimes against God's laws}, He was crushed {and bruised} for our wickedness [our sin, our injustice, our wrongdoing]; The punishment [required] for our well-being fell on {was thrust upon} Him, And by His stripes (wounds) {and bruises} we are healed.”

“Yet it was our weaknesses he carried; it was our sorrows that weighed him down. And we thought his troubles were a punishment from God, a punishment for his own sins! But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was

beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed.” Isaiah 53:4-5 NLT

“But he was wounded for the wrong we did; he was crushed for the evil we did. The punishment, which made us well, was given to him, and we are healed because of his wounds.”
Isaiah 53:5 NCV

“...with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole.”
Isaiah 53:5 AMPC

“When the even was come, they brought unto him [Jesus] many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.”
Matthew 8:16-17 KJV

“Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.” 1 Peter 2:24 KJV
