Subject: "Meditate and Meditation" in the Bible:

"Meditate": From "Strong's Exhaustive Concordance"

Commune, complain, declare, meditate, muse, pray, speak, talk with. A primitive root; to ponder, i.e. (by implication) converse (with oneself, and hence, aloud) or (transitively: One **meditated** on a saying.) utter — commune, complain, declare, meditate, **muse**, pray, speak, talk (with).

• **MUSE**: *verb intransitive* Latin musso and mussito, to mutter or murmur... The Greek signifies to press, or utter sound with the lips compressed. Latin mussitatio: The word then primarily denotes what we call humming, to hum, as persons do when idle, or alone and steadily occupied and pondering.

- **Muse** in this Scriptures case, seems to mean: To be steadily occupied and pondering, and saying or speaking to one's self in a thoughtful manner.

- [1 Timothy 4:15 KJV](#)

15 Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.

Greek: **Meletao (Meditate)**: used of the Greeks of the meditative pondering and the practice of orators and rhetoricians.

RHETORI'CIAN, *noun* (from **Rhetoric**: The art of speaking with propriety, elegance and force.) **Propriety**: conformity to established standards of good or proper behavior or manners. **Orator**: One who speaks in public.

RHETORI'CIAN:

1. One who teaches the art of rhetoric, or the principles and rules of correct and elegant speaking...

2. One well versed in the rules and principles of rhetoric.

3. An orator.
