The Precious Holy Spirit - Our Comforter - Our Teacher

Various terms used for receiving the Holy Spirit, in overflowing measure, after one is born again:

1. Baptized with the Holy Spirit (or Holy Ghost)
2. Gift of the Holy Spirit (or Gift of the Holy Ghost)
3. Give the Holy Spirit
4. The Promise of My Father (or Promise of the Father)
5. Endued with power from on high
6. Receive (or received) the Holy Ghost-receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit
7. Receive Power after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you
8. The Promise of the Holy Ghost (or just “the Promise”)
9. Filled with the Holy Ghost (or Holy Spirit)
10. (Holy Ghost) fallen upon them
11. Anointed...with the Holy Ghost and with power
12. The Holy Ghost fell on all them...
13. Poured out the Gift of the Holy Ghost
14. God gave them the like Gift
15. Full of the Holy Ghost
16. Giving them the Holy Ghost
17. Have you received the Holy Ghost since you believed?
18. The Holy Ghost came on them
19. The Holy Ghost was given
20. The Gift of God

Mark 1:8 “...(Jesus) shall **baptize you with the Holy Ghost.**”

Luke 11:13 “If you...know how to give good **gifts** to your children: how much more shall your Heavenly Father **give the Holy Spirit** to them that ask Him?”

Luke 14:49 “...I send **the Promise of My Father** upon you...until you be **endued with power from on high.**”

John 20:22 “...(Jesus) breathed on them...**Receive ye the Holy Ghost.**”

Acts 1:4-5 “And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the **promise of the Father**, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be **baptized with the Holy Ghost** not many days hence.”

Acts 1:8a “But ye shall **receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you...**”

Acts 2:33 “Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father **the promise of the Holy Ghost**, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.”

Acts 2:38-39 “Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall **receive the gift of the Holy Ghost**. For **the promise** is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.”

Acts 4:8 “Then Peter, **filled with the Holy Ghost**, said unto them...”

Acts 4:29-31 “And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all **filled with the Holy Ghost**, and they spake the word of God with boldness.”

Acts 7:55 “But (Stephen), being **full of the Holy Ghost**, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God...”

Acts 8:14-17 “Now when the apostles which were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John: Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might **receive the Holy Ghost**: (For as yet he was **fallen upon** none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) Then laid they their hands on them, and they **received the Holy Ghost**.”

Acts 9:17 “And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be **filled with the Holy Ghost**.”

Acts 10:38 “How God **anointed** Jesus of Nazareth **with the Holy Ghost and with power**: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.”

Acts 10:44-47 “While Peter yet spake these words, the **Holy Ghost fell** on all them which heard the word. And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was **poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost**. For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter, Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have **received the Holy Ghost** as well as we?”

Acts 11:15-17 “And as I began to speak, the **Holy Ghost fell** on them, as on us at the beginning. Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be **baptized with the Holy Ghost**. Forasmuch then as God gave them the **like gift** as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?”

Acts 11:24 “...(Barnabas) was a good man, and **full of the Holy Ghost**...”

Acts 13:9-12 “Then (Paul) **filled with the Holy Ghost**...(blinded Elymas the sorcerer)...”

Acts 13:51-52 “(After suffering persecution and being expelled from Antioch)...they shook off the dust of their feet against them, and came unto Iconium. And the disciples were **filled with joy, and with the Holy Ghost**.”

Acts 15:8-9 (Peter speaking) “And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare (the gentiles) witness, **giving them the Holy Ghost**, even as he did unto us; And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.”

Acts 19:1-6 “And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, He said unto them, Have ye **received the Holy Ghost** since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, **the Holy Ghost came on them**; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.”
